Walking in advertising

DESCRIPTION: advertising resin coating based in the application of advertising posters and spots coated by special transparent resins of the DEGA- MONOSINT® line, solvent-free, anti-slippery and class 1 fireproof.

STREET SPOT is applicable on surfaces of different nature, and is easily removable thanks to a special detaching primer which assures good adherence and at the same time, when being submitted to steam or hot air at 100°C, it can be removed without leaving residues and without ruining the existing ground.

USE: coat sidewalks, pedestrian ways, exterior floorings, tiles etc. with removable advertising. Street Spot is a walkable and removable surface, particularly indicated for temporary advertising posters and spots.

APPLICATION:

OUR KNOW HOW IN THE PATENTED STREET SPOT

Clean and degrease the surface to be coated. Pour a special detaching resin primer, fix a special paper or textile with Dega Stabil resin. Lay a protective finishing with anti-slippery Gel Coat.

REMOVAL: To remove Street Spot it's sufficient to weaken one of the exterior edges by heating and remove with the possible help of steam, hot water or hot air. Clean the previously coated surface with AP/10 or AP/98, removing any residue in order to bring the surface to its original status, integral and intact.
